The other addition, Heguru@Fusionopolis, focuses on right-brain training during early childhood. The programme originated from Japan, where it has been established for the past 30 years and proven to be

highly effective. The classes are fast-paced, with two teachers facilitating over 40 activities per 50-minute class. These activities include right brain memorisation, looking at flash cards, and moving to rhythms.

Parents waiting for their children to end their lessons can while away the time at F&B outlets like Starbucks, Ya Kun, or Hungry Wich's. After class, reward your children with tidbits from 60s/70s-style snack shop Munch Munch, or an hour of uninhibited fun at Happy Willow Indoor Playground. Various dining establishments such as PastaMania, Penang Place, Koryo (Korean) Restaurant, and Shin Nichi Japanese Restaurant also ensure that you don't have to go too far for meals before or after lessons.
